RESIDENTIAL SWIMMING POOL FILLING POLICY

City of Caro residents are responsible for the filling of their privately owned swimming pools. Pools should be filled from their household water source or by contracting with a private water hauler.

If residents choose to use their household source and do not wish to be charged for both the current water AND sewer rate, they need to contact the City Offices. Residents will be charged for this service as follows:

--During normal hours of operation the charge will be \$15 to read the meter before filling and \$15 to read the meter after filling for a total of \$30. A 24-hour notice is required.

--After hours and on weekends the charge will be \$55 to read the meter before filling and \$55 to read the meter after filling for a total of \$110.

--Pool filling will not exceed 48 hours. There will be no holiday filling.

The sewer usage portion of the water bill will not be charged for the water used between the meter readings if the above procedure is followed.

The Caro Department of Public Works does not fill privately owned swimming pools.

The Caro Fire Department does not fill privately owned swimming pools.
